Clerk's Report – 27 May 2021 Annual Parish Council Meeting

Agenda Item 20 (a) – Chinley Community Centre Project – An update on progress on the project will be provided at the meeting. The April invoice will be presented for approval (£4,350 plus VAT) from architects d3 Associates Ltd. In addition consideration to be given to approving in principle a consultation within the parish on obtaining a loan from the Public Works Loan Board, with a possible impact on the precept, should it be necessary for the Community Centre Project and Car Park resurfacing works. This may form part of the wider consultation necessary for the project.

Agenda Item 20 (b) – Play Area Inspection Reports – Weekly inspection reports to be presented and any matters arising to be discussed.

Agenda Item 20 (c) – Parish Land Inspection Reports – Monthly inspection reports to be presented and any matters arising to be discussed.

Agenda Item 20 (d) – Newsletters 2021/22 – A proposal will be circulated for the frequency and format of newsletters for the current financial year, including a special one-off newsletter to form part of the Community Centre Project consultation.

Agenda Item 20 (e) – Buxworth Fencing – A quote will be presented to repair a section of the hand-rail fencing that comes down to Buxworth Rec from the primary school. Consideration to be given to paying for the repairs or sharing them with Buxworth Primary School.

Agenda Item 20 (f) – Minor Maintenance Scheme 2021/22 – Consider invitation to participate in the 2021/22 Public Rights of Way Minor Maintenance Scheme.

Agenda Item 20 (g) – Chinley Allotments – Chinley Allotments Association previously requested permission in principle to cut down three trees at the far end of the allotment site. They have now organised for a tree surgeon to carry out some of these works and have also organised a skip for allotment holders to have a clean-up of the site. They have requested a financial contribution towards these works.

Agenda Item 20 (h) – Welcome Back Fund – An email has been circulated from High Peak Borough Council in respect of a small pot of money that parish councils may apply for in respect of proposals to welcome people back to the high street. Since Chinley has a row of shops it is eligible to apply. Discussion to be held over projects to be considered for inclusion.
