## **Clerk's Report – November 2018**

**Agenda Item 6 (a) – Chinley Community Centre Project** – Vice Chairman to provide an update from the project group.

**Agenda Item 6 (b) – Playground Inspection Reports** – Weekly inspection reports to be presented at the meeting and any matters arising to be discussed.

**Agenda Item 6 (c) – Chinley Playground Project** – The additional wet-pour surfacing has been carried out to meet the current applicable standards under the Cone Climber – Spinami as requested at the October meeting. We are still awaiting the contractor coming back for other minor issues. An update will be provided at the meeting.

**Agenda Item 6 (d) – First World War Centenary** – The beacon event took place on Squirrel Green on Remembrance Sunday and was well attended. An article has appeared in the Buxton Advertiser. The beacon has now been stored in the storage annexe for possible future use. The Silent Soldiers are still sited on Squirrel Green and on the B6062. We need to agree when these should be taken down and what the plan for them is going forward. The lamppost poppies will be removed by our local Poppy Appeal organiser at the end of November. A summary of expenditure on the Remembrance activities will be presented.

**Agenda Item 6 (e) – Christmas 2018** – Everything is in place for the Christmas trees and lights to be put up w.c. 26 November with the Lights Switch On events to take place the following week as previously detailed. A number of councillors will be required as volunteer marshalls at the Chinley event. A suggestion has been made that a microphone be used at the Christmas Lights event in Chinley.

**Agenda Item 6 (f) – Path around Chinley Community Centre** – Two further quotes are anticipated for these works. An update will be provided at the meeting. Cllr Wilson to update on the possibility of s106 money funding any part of this.

**Agenda Item 6 (g) – Logo** – Cllr Smith carried out an audit of the level of fill of our parish council-owned grit bins. Five out of nine bins required some filling. Chapel DIY Centre Ltd have filled the grit bins further to this audit. We require approval of the invoice for £120 plus VAT.
