- 1.) Chinley & Buxworth Transport Group – copy of Network Rail GRIP report in respect of an accessible route at Chinley Station.
- 2.) Cooper sons Hartley and Williams LLP Solicitors – letter and terms of business with respect the sale of 4 plots of land to the rear of Lower Lane.
- 3.) High Peak Borough Council – details of an application for a New Street Trading Consent for an Ice Cream Van to operate in Chinley. The last date for representations is 22 November 2021.
- 4.) High Peak Borough Council – advising that they are working with the Football Association, Football Foundation and Sport England to refresh the Local Football Facility Plan (LFFP) to reflect changes that have happened and projects that have been delivered since the original plan was written and are interested in knowing what opportunities may exist locally.
- 5.) High Peak Borough Council – confirmation that the Road Closure Order has been granted, signed and sealed in respect of Chinley Remembrance Sunday Event 2021.
- 6.) Derbyshire County Council – advising that the new grit bin on Maybank Close in Chinley has now been installed and is reference number GB5122.
- 7.) High Peak Borough Council - consultation response to the proposal to cease payments in lieu of Council Tax Benefit Support Grants prior to Parish Forum meeting.
- 8.) Chapel-en-le-Frith Parish Cllr Chris Sizeland – sending a copy of a letter received by Robert Lorgan MP from Kemi Badenoch MP Minister of State for Equalities and Levelling Up Communities with details of the grant for local council tax support that replaced the previous council tax benefit in 2013.
- 9.) Derbyshire County Council – advising that they will commence charging £100 per application from 22 November 2021 for the processing of formal licences granted under section 115 of the Highways Act 1980 for the placing out of items on the public highway.
